

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SAGITAL APPLIANCE

- 1. Turn the appliance once or twice a week for the time prescribed.
- 2. Expect some discomfort (soreness or headache) the first few days. This will disappear. Use Aspirin, Tylenol, or Advil for any discomfort.
- 3. Please do not chew gum or sticky foods. Work with your toothbrush to keep the appliance clean.
- 4. It is normal to have trouble pronouncing some words. This will disappear with time.
- 5. The appliance will make the patient salivate. This will subside as time goes on.
- 6. The appliance will be turned for about six months or so, at which time you will stop turning it and the appliance will then serve as a retainer.
- 7. Absolutely do not turn the appliance for more than the prescribed time until seen by Dr. Reiss.
